## Inventory Checklist for Last Will and Testament

#### 1. Personal Assets

- o Jewelry, watches, collectibles, artwork, and other valuables
- Heirlooms or sentimental items (family photos, awards, etc.)
- Digital assets (online accounts, social media, domain names, digital photo libraries)
- Pets and care instructions

#### 2. Financial Assets

- Bank accounts (checking, savings, money market, etc.)
- Investment accounts (stocks, bonds, mutual funds)
- Retirement accounts (401(k), IRA, pension plans)
- Life insurance policies (beneficiary designations)
- Debts owed to the individual (personal loans, promissory notes)
- Cryptocurrency and access details (wallet keys, account login)

# 3. Real Estate and Property

- o All properties owned (homes, vacation properties, land)
- Deeds and titles
- Lease or rental agreements for property rented out
- o Burial plot ownership or pre-paid burial arrangements

## 4. Vehicles and Transport Assets

- o Cars, motorcycles, boats, and recreational vehicles
- Ownership documents and titles
- Service and maintenance records

#### 5. Business Interests

- Ownership of businesses or partnerships
- Stock certificates or ownership agreements
- Succession plan for business, if applicable
- Outstanding invoices or accounts receivable

- Patents, copyrights, trademarks, and royalties

# **Obituary Checklist**

#### 1. Personal Information

- Full name (including maiden name, if applicable) and any commonly known nicknames
- o Date and place of birth and death
- Cause of death, if the family wishes to share

# 2. Family Details

- Names of parents, siblings, spouse(s), children, grandchildren, and other close family members
- Preceded in death by whom (e.g., parents, spouse, children)
- Survived by whom (include family members and special friends)

# 3. Education and Career Highlights

- o Schools, degrees, and academic accomplishments
- o Career or trade highlights, notable contributions or positions held

## 4. Military Service

- o Branch of service, rank, and notable awards or recognitions
- Significant deployments or service contributions

# 5. Community Involvement

- Volunteer work, community organizations, or charity affiliations
- o Memberships (e.g., clubs, religious organizations, fraternal groups)

## 6. Hobbies and Interests

- o Personal passions, hobbies, or activities that were significant
- o Travel, cultural, or sporting interests
- Details that reflect the individual's personality or values

# 7. Special Accomplishments and Honors

- Awards, recognitions, or accomplishments
- Any personal achievements, from sports to arts to civic contributions

### 8. Funeral or Memorial Service Information

- o Time, date, and location of services
- Any preferences for donations in lieu of flowers
- o Details on how friends or family can participate

# 9. Memorable Stories or Quotes

- A short anecdote or quote that captures the person's character
- Favorite sayings or words of wisdom
